## ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

Welcome our new Attendance Coordinator, Mr. Mike Nersinger! From this point forward, please copy Mr. Nersinger on all absences, along with Mrs. Bechtold. Mr. Nersinger will be calling students who are not at rehearsals without excuses just as a reminder. Thank you!

Students may write their own "excuses" to let us know ahead that they will not be at a practice. These can be dropped off in the inbox for Attendance in Mrs Bechtold's room.

Make sure you say hello to Mr Nersinger !!!!!

If you miss a rehearsal, please check with others in the chorus to find what you missed. It's very important that you try to make it to all rehearsals so that you will be ready for show time!

Sometimes there are conflicts between one rehearsal and another. The GENERAL rule of thumb is to go to the first dance rehearsal and then go to vocal rehearsals, alternating so that you get the most out of both. The directors understand this happens, so just ask them or let them know and they will help to work around the conflict. See Mrs. Bechtold if you are having a long term conflict with sports, dance, etc.... We'll do our best to work with you as long as we know about it!!!!



### **From the Director's Chair:**

I don't think I've sat down once this week! I am loving the energy you are all showing. Keep it up. Stay rested, make healthy decisions. Take your vitamins, eat right and stay hydrated.

### **From the Choreographer's Bag of Shoes:**

Wow!

We have gotten off to a GREAT start.....

Make sure you are practicing in order to keep the dances in your head. I recommend that EVERY cast member should have a small notebook for the show. If you take a few minutes to write down what we do in rehearsal, in your own words, it will help your brain to work with your muscles much easier. By show time, you won't even have to think about it!

When it is snowy or rainy outside, wet shoes should NOT be worn on the dance area in the cafeteria, and NEVER in the dance studio. Wet spots can be dangerous for other students, and damaging to dance shoe soles. Bring an extra pair of dry shoes or socks to wear for rehearsal.

The fun begins on Saturday starting at 10:00 until ~3PM in the costume room (1st floor of Music wing- end of hall). We have been having a great time pulling costumes for the cast and starting to match up costumes to students for fittings.

On Saturday 1/14 we would appreciate it if the members of Hooverville could stop by the hallway outside the cafeteria to be fitted for a costume anytime between 11-2:30. Should last no more than 10-15 minutes tops!

Costumes meets Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Costume Room, and Saturdays 10-3.

Please bring your machine, if you have one, along with sewing scissors and extension cords. We have limited room inside the costume room for machines, but we may be able to get some tables for out in the hall. We do have sessions where the middle school kids can join us, and we communicate this information every week. We ask they not attend yet (with the exception of Danielle DiCecca our fabulous high school assistant), but we will have plans for students soon.

## **HEALTH/NURSE INFORMATION**

Food at rehearsals – please be aware that we have children with peanut allergies. **DO NOT BRING** any peanut products for lunch or snacks (i.e. peanut butter sandwiches or reeses peanut butter cups)... Make sure that you do bring water and enough healthy food to keep your energy levels going. Try to get plenty of sleep! Your body needs to adjust to all this extra work!

Allergies, Medical Conditions – Thank you to those who have communicated allergies via the parent info form already. If you have not and your child has a medical issue, please either fill in the info form or send a note directly to our lead nurse, Kathy Gorall at [kgorall@rochester.rr.com](mailto:kgorall@rochester.rr.com). All student information will be kept confidential. Do not assume that because the school knows, we will know. Due to confidentiality rules, this information must come direct from the parent to us.... If anyone has a specific skin allergy that makeup may aggravate, we would also like to know that so the makeup committee can follow up with you.

With cold weather, we need to minimize transfer of germs and sickness amongst the cast. They are spending hours together from this time forward... It's all basic stuff, but we need to stress it.....Wash your hands and cover your mouth/nose .... Parents, please send students with Kleenex if they have a runny nose.... Wear hats/gloves/scarves/socks....Long pants should also be worn- especially outside. Parents – Please stress this with your kids!

From the school nursing staff, district policy must prevail even at rehearsals. If students require medication during a rehearsal, parents should administer it. School rules for non-prescription drugs such as Tylenol, Advil, etc... should apply. OK to carry inhalers or epi pens if needed. If you have any specific issues, let Kathy know and we'll try to work with you.

## **GENERAL NOTES**

- \*Everyone dances AND sings during the chorus numbers unless you are told otherwise by a director. Please look to attend both vocal rehearsals with Mrs. Bechtold , Mrs. Robinson, or Miss Taylor, as well as dance rehearsals with Miss Larkin and Jamie Heinrich.
- \*If you come early, or are staying for another rehearsal, PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL of the current rehearsal. Stay in the back of cafeteria and keep your voices low. Respond immediately to directions from Chaperones or Directors/Staff.
- \*Check the schedules in email or outside Mrs. Bechtold room REGULARLY. New rehearsals will be added as deemed necessary.
